INFORMATION ABOUT ACCESS ON DAYS OF TOTAL FIRE BAN IN THE ACT

On days when a Total Fire Ban is declared in the ACT there are restrictions on access to areas controlled by the ACT Government.

Note that it states: "In an effort to accommodate recreational users, the Canberra Nature Park and all pine forest areas (other than Kowen Forest) will remain open to the public during the early morning hours, however, users are advised that they should leave these areas no later than 11 am."

[Canberra Nature Park](#) comprises all the Canberra Nature Reserves like Mt Ainslie Nature Reserve and Black Mountain Nature Reserve. Mulligans Flat Woodlands Sanctuary is closed on days of Total Fire Ban and the new fencing could make the use of Goorooyarroo Nature Reserve unsafe.
